I want to strongly support reopening of the 2020-2021 budget by the legislature to restore funding for public libraries. The current 5/12th appropriation equals a 58% reduction from 2019 annual funding for the Henrietta Hankin Branch Library. Result is a potential decrease of over \$50,000 specific to my library.

This decrease in funding will cause severe, negative effects on the programs and services that our community library provides your constituents.
